User and Installation Guide

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Virto JQuery Tab Navigation for Microsoft SharePoint

Overview

Virto JQuery Tab Navigation is a special web part for quick and easy grouping of web parts placed on a SharePoint site page.

Standard view of SharePoint site page allows adding more than one component to a site page. As a result the page is overfilled with web parts and users need to use scrolling every time they try to find a required component.

With help of Virto JQuery Tab Navigation you can group all the controls on the page into several tabs. All the tabs can be easily renamed or put into a certain order according to your working scheme.

Moreover, with Virto JQuery Tab Navigation you can apply different color themes and define color scheme for tabs page.

Installation and Activation

This section describes how to install, upgrade, uninstall, or contact Support for the Virto JQuery Tabs.

Expected Outage

The expected outage time is from 2 minutes to several hours depending on your hardware and number of SharePoint sites. Though we recommend all Virto users to upgrade on a weekend.


Installing Virto JQuery Tab Navigation

Before you begin, you need to make sure you have access to the server and your account must have the appropriate administrative privileges to install applications.


Virto JQuery Tab Navigation for SharePoint setup program provides links to the various installation components for the calendar.

To access Virto JQuery Tab Navigation Setup program download **Virto.SharePoint.TabsX.X.zip** file and unzip it. Run extracted **Setup.exe** file.

The setup wizard window will appear.




Virto JQuery Tab Navigation wizard performs a system check prior to the installation. All the system checks must be completed successfully in order to proceed with the installation. After the checks have completed, click "Next".




Check "I accept the terms in the License Agreement" and click "Next".

Select the web application(s) where you want to install the product.


Warning: You must be logged in to the SharePoint server with a Site Collection Administrator account to automatically activate this feature.



Then click "Next".



Click "Close" to complete the installation.

Upgrading Virto JQuery Tab Navigation

If you already use Virto JQuery Tab Navigation and need to upgrade it to the latest version, download the prom http://www.virtosoftware.com. Unzip the file and run setup exe as it is described in the Installing Virto JQuery Tab Navigation section.

On the step 3 check the box "Upgrade" and click "Next".

Note: if you had activated the license while installing the previous Virto JQuery Tab Navigation version, you do not need to activate it now.

Uninstalling Virto JQuery Tab Navigation


To uninstall the component:

Double click the Setup.exe extracted from downloaded Virto.SharePoint.TabsX.X.zip file. The program performs the system checks again. Once that has successfully completed, the program prompts you to Repair or Remove the solution. Select Remove, and click "Next".


Administration and Usage

Adding Web Part to a SharePoint site


Go to SharePoint site where you want to add the calendar and open "Site Actions - Edit page". You will switch to edit mode.



Click "Add a Web Part".




Select Virto JQuery Tab Navigation at the bottom of the list and click "Add".



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Once you have clicked "Add" button, use "Exit edit mode" button.




Added web part will be displayed on page. To adjust it, go to web part settings.


Virto JQuery Tab Navigation Settings

Virto Tab Navigation provides a group of tabs that control other web parts in a zone or on the page, so SharePoint users can view them in groups rather than scrolling.

When the feature is activated and added to a SharePoint site page, you can group tabs according to your needs. For example, we have a page with several controls in different web part zones. The page template consists of top content right content and left content and looks as follows:




On top of the page is installed and added Virto JQuery Tab Navigation.




Grouping into Tabs

To group controls into tabs, go to web part settings ("Modify Shared Web Part" button) and use "Generate tabs" button.



You can select one of two options:

- Current web part zone (in this case tabs only from current web part zone will be selected)
- All web part zones on page (in this case you can group tabs from all web part zones placed on the site page).



Let us choose "All web part zones on page" option. The tabs will be generated automatically – one tab for every web part present on the page.




Editing Tabs

To edit tab click "Edit" button.



Here you can define tab name and web part that will be included into this tab (in this case we have only one web part). Click "Save" to save the tab settings.




You can define name for all the tabs and changer the order of them the page. Click "Create new" if you need to add more tabs to the page.




As a result three web parts are grouped into tabs and reordered on the page. Now it is much easier to navigate to required section and find information you need.


Tab 1 (Product Overview):



Tab 2 (Purchase Information):




Splash Screen

You can use the checkbox "Hide splash screen". This option is switched off by default. If you check this box, splash screen will not be shown while loading of site page with tabs. When this option is activated, SharePoint user will just see jumping over of the content when tabs are initialized after loading.




Color Themes


Moreover you can apply different color themes to your tabs page.






Note: all of the schemes are JQuery designed and can be customized as .css file (see Custom Themes section).

Virto JQuery Tab Navigation Use Case


With help of Virto Tab Navigation you can easily combine web part into tabs. For example, you have several web parts on your SharePoint site page and the page seems overloaded with components (Alerts Customizer, File Uploader and Password Changer).




Just add Virto Tab Navigation to this page as described in previous section.




And use "Generate tabs" button in Tabs web part settings for all web part zones.



Then let us shorten titles of web parts (tabs) and change the order from:



To:




And apply azure theme.




As a result we have three tabs on page.


Virto Password Changer tab:

And Virto File Uploader tab:




Note: the current version of Virto jQuery Tab Navigation supports grouping of **static page content** (web parts that contain static html). Dynamic web parts may work with errors (for instance Calendar or Charts).

Custom Themes


Virto jQuery Tab Navigation allows users to customize themes in css files and add new themes right to the web part.

Themes can be easily customized with help of <u>ThemeRoller</u>. Go to the <u>jqueryui.com</u> and use ThemeRoller to create a custom theme.



Then download this theme as css file (zip archive).






Rename .css file extracted from the archive to *YourTheme.css* and "images" folder to *YourTheme*. Then replace "images/" string with "YourTheme/". Copy YourTheme.css file and the folder with images "YourTheme" to the folders on server where SharePoint is installed:

 $c:\program Files\common Files$

The theme will appear in the list of themes in Tab Navigation web part settings.



Just select it to apply to Tabs.



This way you can generate any themes you like and add them to your web part on SharePoint site.

The Sequence of Pages Editing when Publishing

In case of publishing pages the sequence of editing must be the following:

- 1) Add desired web parts to the page.
- 2) Configure them.
- 3) Add Virto Tabs web part (do not configure it).
- 4) Check In the page.
- 5) Configure Virto Tabs web part. Option "Group web parts from" must be set to "All web part zones on page". If you do not want to place any web parts into tabs, just remove them explicitly from the tabs.

Every time you add a new web part to the publishing page, you have to check in the page to allow Virto Tabs web part seeing it in the list of web parts page.
